Finnish life from a french perspective

- Many teenagers have a job after school.
- They do not have an adequate schedule for eating
- They do not use the car much: there is subway, bus, streetcar, bicycle or just walk
- Parents are less strict, it is safer.
- Everyone has a phone from very early in the morning

French life from a finnish perspective

- The schooling system is very different
 - Long days with homework
 - Student teacher relationship is different (not so much an authority figure)
- Young people smoke a lot; not so much in Finland
- Different food culture (starter, main, dessert)
- People are more social (ex. with strangers)
- Children are less independent (car travelling)
